### Appeal and Complaint :

1. This letter has a reference to Pharmacy Act 1948 and timely amendments there after and also has a reference to Maharashtra State Pharmacy Rule (MSPC Rule) 1969 and amendments there after as a activist when I was reading the said both acts in terms of Chapter IV, section 29 to section 40 read together with Chapter V with its section 46 which states about power to make rules by states.

2. As a Pharmacy activist and registered Pharmacists of Maharashtra State while reading the Chapter Above mentioned sections and the Rule 46 of Chapter V of Pharmacy Act it can be understood that MSPC Rule is in existence as MSPC Rule 1969 and amendments are made timely by State Government of Maharashtra State.

3. As a activist I observed that procedure of entry of name of registered pharmacists in State register has made Online through web portal, before 10/10/2018 this procedure was as per the provision of the said act and registrar was doing their duty of verification

of all documents and entering the names in register (Chapter IV and V of the Pharmacy Act 1948)

4. Since 10/10/2018 to till date The online registrations are taken with online verification of documents and online fees paid in this regards, Maharashtra state Pharmacy Council has nicely elaborated procedure on its website on [www.mspscindia.org](http://www.mspscindia.org) It can also observed that registrar has given authority to Principal of colleges to verify documents of the pharmacy students at their end by online means and surprisingly this is having only provision of approving and rejection and no provision of remark or anything in the same.

5. Furthermore as a part of registration process on your portal it can be observed that there is provision of Pharmacists Personal Profile card PPP Card applications, for which as activist I had made complaint previously also for its legal status and its provision in law but there was no proper answer from the registrar of council

Note : PPP Card is not applicable anywhere in Pharmacists Life

6. Further I submitting that Renewal of the registration also being done through online portal by taking prescribed fees.

7. Further I submitted my statement that the NRD as per government GR is being taken as deposit for renewal as per Pharmacy Act is being taken in randomised way and with multiple complaints also council had not provided any calculation for the same

8. I submit with all due respect that Online registration and PPP Card both the things are not mentioned in MSPC Rule 1969 Or in the Pharmacy Act 1948 or it's amendments there after, or neither I have found any Government Regulation or GR available on MSPC website or with Government of Maharashtra, when I as activist tried to ask registrar of council they had just given answer that it has been decided by Full council meeting resolution, my question is that is full council has right to overrule the provisions of Law ?

9. I appeal Authorities if Maharashtra Government please investigate the matter of Online registration without having provision in law in the light of regulations and permissions taken by Registrar


10. It needs to be cancelled all registrations which are done through online procedure and without permission portal with immediate effect from the date 10/10/2018 till today

11. As a activist I am submitting that the registration procedure if are found to be illegal during investigation shall be deemed as bogus pharmacists and it's a big play with health of public because such pharmacists are working in medical stores and giving medicines to public till date and it's dangerous and hazardous to public health

Evidence : FIR has been logged by Council on many Pharmacists who have submitted bogus documents such cases may be more if scrutinised with Physical verification

12. I urge council authority and Maharashtra state government please investigate the same and take serious action on the authorities and Members of council who are involved in this serious decision if found guilty in investigation, Request the investigation through independent authority

13. Further I am submitting my complaint against unauthorised implementation of PPP Card system illegally without having statutory provision of PPP Card in the Pharmacy Act





1948 and also in MSPC Rule 1969 without having permission from Government of Maharashtra it has been implemented, when I have asked relevance and reason for the same the council registrar had not given any answer in terms of law, they had given irrelevant communications from other department of State government, it is not right of council to implement any document as a mandatory document and take money for the same without having provision and prescribed fees in law, hence I further submit that consider this case as corruption and investigate the same through police or CID wing of Maharashtra Police and need to be pay all money extracted to the Pharmacists back.

14. Further Maharashtra Government as per MSPC Rule 1969 Chapter II had declaimed its election through notification no MSPC / 03/2022, dt. 18/01/2022 and process of election is going on Considering illegal base of online registration, it can be observed that the electoral roll has been created published and made available for sale to contestants through notification is having Registered pharmacists names who are registered and renewal done through online registration system shall be considered as invalid and the said election process has to be stopped immediate effect till rectification of electoral roll with the illegal based registration the voters becomes invalid or bogus and the election can not be fare to conduct. I request stop the same till investigation

15. With above statement of complaint Input this as a classic example of negligence, lethargic approach and carelessness on this part of competent authority who are entrusted with the legal duty to enforce the legal entactment in order to serve public health

16. Further as a responsible citizen and a registered Pharmacist of state I would like to brought the commencement of the above offences to the notice of the competent authorities of Maharashtra Government

17. Without any prejudice I request Government of Maharashtra to investigate the matter on law point and have to be checked strictly whether law has been followed or not in above points, I request to restrict all administrative and registration rights of the registrar till the conclusion of the investigation

18. Further Requesting to keep the complaint confidential and send the answer to me as earliest on the action, Please note this is very serious public health issue and I afraid that the concerned peoples or authority may threaten me or my family so need support and protection of confidentiality from Government of Maharashtra
